Purpose of processing of personal data and the legal basis for the processing

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of participation in the webinar "Climate risks for agriculture – data sources".

The recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

Your personal data may be transferred to entrepreneurs providing IT services to the Ministry of Climate and Environment, and for the purpose of organizing the webinar – Cisco Webex Meetings.

Your personal data may be disclosed to other bodies authorized on the legal basis. Those authorities are not data recipients within the meaning of GDRP.

If you use the chat function, your personal data will be shared with other webinar participants.

The period for which the personal data will be stored

Personal data will be processed for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purpose of data processing, which is participation in the webinar "Climate risks for agriculture – data sources", but no longer than until November 21, 2025.

Rights of data subjects

The Controller ensures that all persons whose personal data is processed have appropriate rights resulting from the GDPR. Therefore, you have:

- the right to access personal data, including the right to obtain a copy
- the right to rectify personal data
- the right to erase the data
- the right to request the restriction to the processing of personal data
- the right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
