Wednesday 22 May - Site visits

8:30 - 17:00 - Site visit to Wallonia: Visit to the Vesdre Valley (optional)

This visit to the Vesdre Valley in Liège Province will unravel the many aspects of the reconstruction and adaptation process that followed the unprecedented flooding in the summer of 2021, which caused significant damage. It will include visits to the Gileppe Dam.

10:30 - 17:00 - Site visit to Flanders: Visit to the city of Mechelen and the Vrouwvliet river (optional)

This visit to the historic city of Mechelen in Antwerp will include a boat ride to explore of its pioneering approaches to incorporating water and greenery into the urban landscape, as well as a walk around the Vrouwvliet river to see ongoing aquatic conservation efforts.

13:30 - 17:00 - Site visit in Brussels: Visit to Tour & Taxis / Brussels port (optional)

This exploration of the neighborhood around Tour & Taxis includes visits to a new park where nature-based solutions are increasing quality of life, to an old industrial district which has been transformed into a pioneering sustainable neighborhood, and to a company turning waste into carbon-neutral building material.

13:30 - 17:00 - Site visit in Brussels: Visit to Sonian Forest (optional)

This walking tour of a UNESCO World Heritage site and exceptional ecosystem will address how we can make forests more resilient; how Urban Forest Based Solutions (UFBS) can help strengthen urban population's wellbeing and health in a changing climate, and how innovations in a circular economy can support sustainable forestry management.
